

Center Stage Dress Code

It is important that students come dressed as indicated below for class. Teachers need to be able to see correct body alignment. Students will be given a dress code reminder when they are not dressed appropriately for class. Parents will also be reminded. Repeat occurrences will result in students sitting out from class.

BTJ Combination - any color leotard and tights, skirt/shorts optional, pink ballet and tan tap shoes, hair in ballet bun

Ballet and Pointe - any color leotard and tights, pink ballet or pointe shoes, hair in a neat ballet bun, no shorts or skirts (except Ballet I; they have the option to wear a skirt or shorts over their leotard)

Lyrical/Cont. – any color leotard and tights, dance shorts optional, pirouette shoes, hair in ponytail

Jazz, Dance/Drill, Leaps & Turns - any color leotard and tights, dance shorts optional, nude jazz shoes, hair in ponytail

Hip-Hop - any color leotard/tank, shorts/pants, black and white low-top Converse (generic brand is fine), hair in a ponytail

Tap – any color leotard/tank, shorts/pants, tan tap shoes, hair in ponytail

Tumble/Pom, Musical Theater - any color leotard/tank, shorts/pants, nude jazz shoes, hair in ponytail

Company Classes - any color leotard and tights, dance shorts optional, pirouette shoes and nude jazz shoes, hair in neat ballet bun
